The Club Delegates are the key interface with Rugby Committees and the Council of Delegates at Auckland Rugby.

Their key responsibilities are:

1. Expected to read, understand and abide by Union Bylaws
2. To conduct themselves in a professional and business-like manner while representing the Club and Union.
3. Expected to attend regular management or sub-committee meetings.
4. Acting as a Club Liaison, making sure the right information is passed through to the right people.
5. Administration of the Union Players – to help with the administration and organisation of the following:

a) Registration of players

b) Transfer of players

c) Discipline of players/judicial requirements

d) Travel requirements of teams

e) Competition format and rules

6. Special NZRU Requirements
7. Special Duties
8. Training

No correspondence will be entered into on Club matters from anyone but a Club representative; this being the Chairman, Delegate, Rugby Administrator and/or General Manager.
