There will be a competition controller and referees on site for all games, juniors will play at 6pm and senior at 7pm. Game length is subject to change depending on entry numbers, these games could be made slightly longer if entries allow. This will be confirmed once entries close.

- 20 Minute games with running clock (TBC Could be slightly longer games depending on entry numbers)
- Same rules as last year
- Fouls recorded and subs in through the bench

Defaults: We understand that defaults do arise, however please note that signing up to this competition means there will be an element of travel involved. If your team needs to default their match, you must email events@osssa.org.nz and the opposition school before 12pm on Monday (game day) informing all parties of the default. Any default notifications after 12pm should be done via phone call. Avoid leaving voice mails and texts, ensure that you physically speak with OSSSA AND the opposition school to notify them of the default to ensure they get the message.

Teams should only use players from their own school, unless a composite team form has been submitted to and approved by OSSSA. Using players from another school without prior approval from OSSSA will result in the team losing the game by default.

Seniors can NOT play down in the junior grade, unless the senior player has received a dispensation approval from OSSSA to play down a grade. If a senior plays in a junior grade without prior approval from OSSSA, the team will lose the game by default.

Using any other ineligible player will result in a loss by default.

A friendly game can still be played if a team cannot source a legitimate team for a game, however the result for the points table will be recorded as a default.

- 1. Maintain the spirit in which this competition has been designed for
- 2. Work together to ensure the competition is a success and caters for all schools/levels
- 3. Fulfil your 'host' obligations by:
 - a. ensure games start on time
 - b. referee is supplied or communication is made with opposition re a plan for officiating the game
