CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

1. The event will be run according to the 2017 Speedway New Zealand General Rules and Regulations.
2. All drivers must hold a current SNZ Inc. Licence and all vehicles must comply with, The current Speedway New Zealand Rule book and supplementary regulations under **Technical and Racing Rule T11-5**
3. **Noise level of 95dba** will be enforced as measured on the track infield.
4. **Electronic Lap scoring will be used.** Vehicles without a transmitter will not be permitted to race. Gisborne Speedway does not provide transmitters.
5. Smoking is prohibited in the pits and dummy grid area at all times.
6. All entry forms must be accompanied by a track clearance
6. The Promoter reserves the right to issue **temporary numbers** to avoid Duplication. Competitors will be advised of any such change to their racing number.

- 7 The promoter reserves the right to alter the format and closing date after consultation with officials, if deemed necessary. You will be notified of any such changes.
- 8 **Technical Inspections** – Please pay attention to Rules **E2-3-1 to E2-3-5**.
- 9 Sponsors advertising transfers may be affixed on each car.
- 10 Telephone entries will be accepted prior to written entry. Entries close **Sunday 30th December 2018**.

- 12 In the event that you have already forwarded an entry form and discover that you are unable to attend this meeting, you must notify us as soon as possible.
- 13 In the event of a rainout the meeting will be run on Sunday 20th Jan 2019, or on the next most opportune day and time at Gisborne Speedways discretion in consultation with SNZ.
- 14 **Alcoholic beverages** must not be consumed in the Pits any time before or during the meeting. The bar in the Clubrooms will be open after racing.
- 15 There is no entry fee for this Championship. ****However, a LATE Entry FEE of \$50.00*** Will be charged for Any Entries Received After the Closing Date of 30/12/18.

Race Format:

Qualifying (depending on number of entries)

Competitors will be split into even groups, each group will race 3 heats of 12 laps each, Grids will be front, middle and back. Points will be accumulated over three heats and the top 20 Qualifiers will go through to top qualifying group. In the event of a tied points situation, the vehicle with the fastest lap time during qualifying will go through.

Finals – Top 20 Qualifiers

M4-28-2

Finals will consist of 20 Competitors racing over three heats. Final Heats to be 15 Laps. Points will be awarded as per finishing position from 20 points for 1st to 1 point for 20th regardless of whether the car crosses the finishing line. Highest Points Scorer over three heats will be deemed the Winner. In case of a tie-on points for first, second or third a 4 Lap Run off will be held.
