Te Whānau Tupuranga ki Papatoetoe North is a group of classes which delivers the New Zealand Curriculum in a Māoritanga focused environment. Teaching and learning happens in and through Te Reo Māori between 30-70% of the school day. Tikanga Māori is part of the learning environment; including powhiri, karakia and kapa haka.

Deliberate teaching of Te Reo Māori is an integral part of the curriculum and Reo Māori is taught based along learning levels that have been designed and adapted by Te Whānau Tupuranga teachers .

Embracing the whānau concept, whānau are encouraged to attend our Whānau Hui that take place every term. The agenda is to ensure the whānau, teachers' and students' needs are being met and to hear about the aspirations of whānau.

There are three classrooms – Years 1 – 2, Years 3 – 4, and Years 5 – 6, and a maximum of 25 students to optimise success.
