Notes: Payments exceeded income in 2018.

Significant expenditure: Shared Rally \$3400, \$1100 Examinations, \$1500 Coaches clinics.

These funds have been put back into the riders and coaches as they should be.

The caravan expenses are covered by income received when it is hired to other organisations.

Stu advised there are 14 bookings already confirmed to November 2019.

A huge thank you was passed on to Stu and Sara for all the work they do in hiring the caravan and tracking all of the equipment in the caravan.

The purchase of the caravan was funded by a significant grant from NZCT. NZCT have confirmed they do not require funds to be returned to them if the caravan is surplus to CPC requirements however they would like to see the caravan remain available for the local equestrian community's use.

Gaye has discussed with the NEC, if CPC can no longer house the caravan at Canterbury Park they are happy for it to be housed at the NEC under cover. NEC would cover the cost of insurance and maintenance and it would remain available to CPC branches at no cost. Gail is in the process of the stocktake.
