

#### Four Day Ramble 3<sup>rd</sup> to 6<sup>th</sup> February 2024 Rod O'Beirne has put this together for a 'long' weekend incorporating Waitangi Day and as a possible precursor to heading down south to the Burt Munro event. Saturday 3rd February – ride to Hanmer Springs – via Kaikoura? Or Lewis **Pass? Or Molesworth Station?** Sunday 4th February – ride to Akaroa. Options – a long ride – thru Lewis Pass to Reefton, then Arthurs Pass -or- into Christchurch via markets &/Or eateries, or cruising the Banks Peninsular Hill before arriving in Akaroa.
