## 2023 ROK CUP SUPERFINAL WILD CARD ENTRIES



### Two Expert ROK CUP Superfinal Wild Card Entries Reserved

We are delighted to confirm that we have secured two reserved Wild Card seats for Expert ROK (32 years and older) or Expert Plus (45 years and older) at the 2023 ROK Cup Superfinal for eligible senior competitors contesting the Vortex ROK DVS class in the 2023 ROK Cup NZL Series. Details and conditions are as follows:

- *These reserved seats will be allocated to the first two placed eligible competitors registered and competing in the Vortex ROK DVS class in the 2023 ROK Cup NZL Series.*
- *Competitors must arrange appropriate Racing Licence, Starting Permission Visa and International Medical Card via KartSport New Zealand.*
- *Competitor must supply appropriate racing apparel which meets current CIK-FIA karting regulations (note rib/chest protector and Junior helmet requirements). Note: opportunity to purchase 2023 Team NZL suits at discounted price.*
- *Competitor and mechanic must arrange valid passports and travel Visas required for international travel to Italy.*
- *Supreme Kart Supplies and Vortex reserve the right to withhold the prize or reallocate the prize should the initial recipients lose their KartSport New Zealand Competition Licence after the final round of 2023 ROK Cup New Zealand and before the 2023 ROK Cup Superfinal.*

- *The competitor has until 30 June 2023 to accept the reserved Wild Card seat at the 2023 ROK Cup Superfinal. If the seat is not accepted/confirmed it will be offered to the next placed 2023 Rok Cup NZL Series eligible competitor respectively.*
- *Note: KartSport New Zealand Rule Q4.9 applies. ROK Cup Superfinal prizes are awarded on a "use it or lose it" basis.*
- *Support from the KartSport Academy Team NZ programme.*
- *Any travel restrictions imposed by either the New Zealand or Italian Governments that result in the awarded seats being unable to be used is not the responsibility of ROK Cup New Zealand, Supreme Kart Supplies or KartSport New Zealand. Force majeure applies.*
- *Vortex ROK DVS Senior competitors will contest either Expert ROK (32 years and older) or Expert Plus (45 years and older) at the 2023 ROK Cup Superfinal.*

ROK EXPERT PLUS	From 45 years old (from 44 years old if 45 by the end of the current year) Superfinal Engine: ROK GP. MAW 170kg

Wild Card entry to other Superfinal classes is subject to availability. In past years kiwi competitors have gained Wild Card entries to Vortex Mini ROK, Junior ROK and Super ROK classes.
