# <u>Dressage – Becci Thomas</u>

The CAPC Dressage team had a successful trip to Gore. There was a bit of a rocky start with lame ponies.

The top team came 1st in the South Island and 1st in New Zealand. The second team came 4th in the South Island and around 7th nationally.

Katie Fitzsimons, Junior and Ella Fitzsimons, Intermediate both won their classes. Evie Eaton, Senior won best 1st time senior.

There were a few issues with scoring. One of the judges who judged the North Island competition could not attend the South Island competition so the fairest thing was to withdraw her scores from the NI results. Originally Canterbury were not awarded 1st place, but after several hours of painstaking paper and pencil work, Becci alerted the organising committee to the error. It was NOMINATE at fault. Eventually the Canterbury team were awarded their ribbons but without the normal pomp and ceremony.

## **Show Jumping – Becci Thomas**

A lot of the Dressage riders also competed on the Show Jumping team.

The course was a tough one and the riders coped really well. They were always fighting time. Course walks started at 7am and the jumping started at 8am. Riders were not allowed to walk the course again.

The team came 2nd in the South Island and 3rd nationally. Becci mentioned that the jumping could have been spread out more.
