HELPFUL HINTS FOR ALL BOWLERS

Points to consider before taking the green

- · Always arrive in plenty of time to competitions and games
- When making payment for your entry into a tournament full team entry is payable to the controlling body - do not pay as an individual player
- Club Uniform is to be worn unless specified otherwise by tournament organiser or by the team you are playing with
- Appropriate footwear is flat heelless soled shoes which means no tread on the sole
- Optional means either Men or Women can make up a team
- Progressive means players rotate positions after each game
- Keep your cellphone turned off or on silent
- It is recommended players read rule 36 of the 'Laws of the Sport of Bowls' which relates to deliberate non-sporting action

Points to consider while on the green

- It is courtesy to walk up the green behind the last person that has bowled while their bowl is still in motion so as not to block their vision
- Whoever is holding the shot bowl on the last end must allow the opposition player to count and remove the shot bowls
- Be courteous to others and remember that positive comments will bring positive outcomes
- Refrain from commenting on oppositions Bowl while in motion
- Be sure to not move around or talk when the opposition is about to bowl
- When walking up to your rink, be sure to stay within your own rink area
- A player may only look at the head when their team has possession of the mat i.e. when oppositions bowl has stopped
- Please refrain from sitting on the bank with your feet in the ditch.

Event Conditions of Play and the Crystal Mark Fourth Edition Laws of the Sport override these conditions in respect of any disputes.

Standard condition of play these regulations of play for Bowls Southland 2024/25 fixtures apply to all players Men, Women, Open, Development (3-5 years) and Novice (1-2 years) and include Clubs participating in Centre competitions.

Tournament controller in the event of adverse weather or other extraordinary circumstances, the Tournament Controller may vary the conditions of play by either reducing the number of games, ends or time. The Tournament Controller's decision shall be final.

Plural/Dual membership entry into Bowls Southland Centre Championship Events is restricted to players that are full members of a club or clubs that are affiliated to the Centre.

Champion of Champion all plural/dual members are required to notify Bowls Southland of the discipline they are playing at each club to which they belong. Players CANNOT compete in a discipline at more than one club within Southland. RESTRICTION OF THE MOVEMENT OF PLAYERS DURING PLAY

Players will only be allowed to walk up to the head under the following circumstances

Singles The opponents after delivery of their third & fourth bowls

Pairs The Leads after the delivery of their third bowls; and

The Skips after delivery of their second and third bowls.

Triples The Leads after delivery of their second bowl

The Seconds after delivery of their second bowl The Skips after delivery of each of their bowls

The Leads after the second player in their team has

delivered their second bowl

Fours

The Seconds after delivery of their second bowl The Thirds after delivery of their second bowl The Skips after delivery of each of their bowls

Draw In all events the qualifying & post section draws will be conducted as a true draw. The Management Committee reserves the right to make suitable arrangements for matters not otherwise provided for. Once a draw is generated, it cannot be changed except for a qualifying draw, where a withdrawal can be filled from the emergency list

Late entries will only be accepted at the discretion of the Management Committee Late withdrawals entry fee will NOT be refunded if withdrawal is received after the event draw has been created

Trial ends pursuant to Law 5.1 the Laws of the Sport trial ends will be allowed before competition commences each day. 1 trial end in each direction shall be competed 10 minutes before start of play.

REGULATIONS - continued

Arrangement for practice pursuant to Law 4.1 4.4.2 if a player or team that has not yet played is due to meet a player or team that has already played on the same day, the player or team that has not yet played can practice as long as approval is granted, enough time allows and/or a rink is available

Score cards (Law 40) the skip shall keep the score card in all disciplines. Score Cards must be completed clearly and in full for every game. The names of all players and the time the game finishes must be entered; score card must be signed by the skips. **Lateness** when any player has failed to be in position to commence play 15 minutes after the scheduled starting time, the game will be awarded to the opponent.

Leaving the venue no player shall leave a venue at any competition without reporting to the controlling body.

In all time limit games if a team is late to start (within the 15 minutes) the following conditions will apply. If the non-offending team is in front on the card after the bell rings the game is finished. If at finish time, the offending team is in front, the non-offending team can request the extra time lost.

Game Stoppages as defined in Rule 33. Skips are required to sign the score cards at the completion, or the end played in the game stopped, before transferring to another venue or day.

Delaying play (time limit) if a player or team delays play the umpire after firstly verbally warning the offending player or team can thereafter impose a penalty as set down in the conditions of play. The penalty would be that one further end is played after the bell, if requested by the non-offending player or team. The matter then would be reported to the controlling body

Substitutes will only be approved by the controlling body under the regulations as set down by Bowls NZ, Regulation 2.

Championships players are reminded that all games need to be played and completed for a team to qualify.

Tied games in the event of a tie in all games an extra end/s shall be played.

Post Section the same number of ends – with time limit.

Final the same number of ends - NO TIME LIMIT

Footwear flat soled heel-less. Any player with a physical disability may use appropriate support, wheelchair or bowling aid, provided that the same is so made that it causes no damage to the green as per Bowls NZ Regulations 13.

Clothing players in a team must be identically attired, **Club shirts to be worn** and teams in pants, shorts or skirts of the same colour.

All players MUST wear their Southland Club uniform they are representing at all events which includes Mixed Pairs and Mixed Triples.

Clothing must comply with the provision Bowls New Zealand Domestic Regulations 14.

REGULATIONS - continued

Smoking / Vaping Policy teams/players visiting other clubs must abide by the rules of the host club. To avoid misunderstanding there is a "no smoking / vaping" policy ban anywhere in the club house or on the greens. Clubs have designated "smoking areas" which must be used by players and officials including markers in singles games.

Cell phones use is **NOT** permitted by players on or alongside the greens during play. It is preferred that all cell phones are switched off or turned to silent.

Prizes awarding of prize money is determined by the number of entries.

Novice and Development 1-5 year player is defined as a player who has been a member of a Club for not more than five years (not necessarily consecutive).

Novice singles confined to 1-2 years – entries confined to players who have not played bowls before October 2022.

Development singles – entries open to 1-5 year players. 1-5 year players may enter the open singles if they wish.

CODE OF CONDUCT FOR PLAYERS AT SOUTHLAND EVENTS OBJECTIVES

To state plainly the way in which players who play in Bowls Southland events are expected to conduct themselves and the consequences of any breach of the expected standards of behavior. To ensure: All players are aware of the standards expected and the consequences of breaching those standards

1. General

This Code of Conduct is to be followed on all occasions and in all places where the player can be seen to be a member of a Club under the jurisdiction of Bowls Southland and includes the venue of play which means the green, surrounds and club house of the place where the player is about to compete, is competing, or has competed.

PLAYER'S OBLIGATIONS

1. The Competition

To maintain at all times a high standard of sportsmanship and fair play. This will of necessity include.

- a. Always playing to the best of their ability and where appropriate to perform as part of a team.
- Abiding by the laws of the game, its regulations and the conditions of play specified by the controlling body.
- Respecting and accepting without question any ruling given by the umpire (subject to any right of appeal given by the Laws).

- d. Not take any performance enhancing substance and in particular strictly to comply with any regulations adopted by Bowls Southland in regard thereto present themselves for competition in an acceptable physical and mental condition and standard of appearance.
- e. Maintain towards opponents an attitude of respect and politeness.

2. Other Occasions

- To refrain from
 - Any behavior which might reflect unfavorably on the game, Bowls Southland, or which might bring any other player, official or Bowls Southland into disrepute
 - II. Making any comment to the media and in particular any public announcement or media comment that might bring the game into disrepute
 - III. Any discriminatory practices based on race, religion, ethnic background or special ability/disability bowlers
- b. To
 - I. Abide by and comply with all directions of Bowls Southland
 - Accept and act upon any judgment of any duly appointed official of Bowls Southland as to any unacceptable behaviour
 - III. Abide by the requirements of Bowls Southland as to dress including sponsor's logos
- Respect the tournament officials, volunteers, officers, members and staff of any Club at which the event is being or has been played
- d. Respect the officers and appointed officials of Bowls Southland.

ANY BREACH OF THE CODE OF CONDUCT

- If the Convenor, having heard any explanation that the player concerned may proffer, persists in any breach of this code of conduct, the Convenor may withdraw that player from the event.
- The Convenor must report breaches of this code of conduct to the controlling body on the prescribed form.
- Any player who is dissatisfied by any action of the Controlling Body of the Day in relation to this code of conduct may request for Bowls Southland to enquire into the conduct in question.

NOTE: This code of conduct has been adopted by Bowls Southland, which requires every player who wishes to play in any Bowls Southland event, to accept these conditions as a means of entry to the event.

INVERCARGILL BOWLS SUB CENTRE INTERCLUB CONDITIONS OF PLAY

Entry into all Interclub events means an undertaking to play by the rules set down by the Invercargill Sub-Centre. Composite entry: Should a club be unable to field a complete team in any event, application may be made to the Sub Centre for consideration of combining with another club. Format of such team to be the responsibility of the clubs involved.

WEATHER INTERVENTION: 5 COMPLETED ENDS CONSTITUTES GAME PLAYED FAIR PLAY/CODE OF CONDUCT see under Code of Conduct for players at Southland events pages 30-31 of this handbook.

DEFAULTS If a club has to default a team, the defaulting team will receive 0 points. The team defaulted to will receive the average points scored by the winning teams in that round

POSTPONEMENTS must be notified at the latest by 11.30am on the day of the scheduled round to the opposing team manager and may be played before the next scheduled round by mutual agreement. If an alternative date cannot be mutually agreed then the team that was unable to field their team on the scheduled date is deemed to have defaulted. Ensure the Convenor of the Match Committee and Match Recorder are informed.

If a club has three or more players (including managers and coaches) in a Southland Representative fixture which clashes with interclub, games may be played before the next interclub round. Please notify recorder of any games or part games postponed.

GREENS host club to prepare green

If a Club has more than one team in any competition it is expected that the Club plays the teams in a squad situation and limits the movement of players between teams.

The Match Committee has final discretion regarding the Interclub competition, defaults, cancellations and fair play.

INTERCLUB CONDITIONS OF PLAY

- Interclub Competition is open to all full members of Clubs belonging to the Eastern Southland Sub Centre of Bowls Southland.
- Affiliated Eastern members of any gender may play in any position.
- All Teams are to have a designated Manager.
- Managers are to draw the rinks prior to the commencement of play and will toss for the team. Both managers are to keep a score sheet.
- · Registered Club colours must be worn.
- · No trial ends before commencement of play.
- Players or teams cannot play or practice on greens set down for them for play later that day.
- Incorrectly delivered jack may be placed by the opposing skip.
- Skips or their appointed player are to record the score on at least one score card and sign the card at the end of play.
- Score sheets to be clearly filled in with players full names.
- Incomplete games that have been stopped due to any adverse circumstance
 i.e. weather the cards are to be signed at the end finished and game is to be
 continued at a future date with the game then commencing at the existing
 score. The home team is to "hold" the cards.
- Postponement due to adverse weather conditions or any emergency is to be notified by 11.30am to the opposing selector and played within 14 days of scheduled date by mutual arrangement and the Convenor of the Match Committee advised.
- Matches should be played in accordance with the fixture book any changes
 to scheduled date of play must be advised to the Convenor of the Match
 Committee along with the new intended date of play.
- Procedure for substitutes or replacements team Selector must advise the Club Captain, who then makes a request to the Convenor of the Match Committee, who will then consult with Match Committee and advise of the decision.
- A default is not acceptable the Match Committee shall set playing dates for rescheduled games if required.
- Disputes and disciplinary issues are to be addressed in accordance with our Centre Constitution with reference to Rules 25.1 to 26. The Judicial Committee may, if they deem appropriate recommend imposing penalties which may include loss of Championship points.

 - Pennants players cannot be interchanged between club teams.




