- 6. Be a financial member of swimming New Zealand
- 7. Be in good standing with swim southland

South Island champs & Division 2

- Bronze coaching qualification, either having attended the course or have this signed off
- 2. Be the coach of record for athletes on the travelling team
- 3. Attend the outlined development opportunities in the SS pathway doc.
- 4. Have experience working with swimmers of this level at meets both locally and out of region.
- 5. Successful police vetting
- 6. Be a financial member of swimming New Zealand
- 7. Be in good standing with swim southland

Nags Opens NZSC

- 1. Silver coaching license, either signed off or having attended course
- 2. Be the coach of record for athletes on the travelling team
- 3. Attend the outlined development opportunities in the SS pathway doc.
- 4. Have experience working with swimmers of this level at meets both locally and out of region.
- 5. Successful police vetting
- 6. Be a financial member of swimming New Zealand
