POSITION DESCRIPTION

Auckland Badminton Association Inc is the regional governing body for the sport of badminton and operates as a non-profit organisation. We are seeking board members to increase our gender balance and diversity with a range of skills to help guide us through the challenges ahead.

The sport is now a game for all ages and is played by increasingly large numbers due to population growth. The sport is currently undergoing an exciting period of revitalisation attracting a broader range of participants including new migrants to Auckland. We seek to establish strong sustainable networks with clubs and the community.

Auckland Badminton has a board of eight members and meets a minimum of 8 times each year.

Four Board Members are elected by the membership and four board members are appointed by the appointments panel.

This is a voluntary role with the opportunity to 'make a difference' and to achieve great satisfaction by contributing to our long established sport.

- Board Selection Panel recommends to the February Annual General Meeting the best candidates for the available positions on the Board based on merit

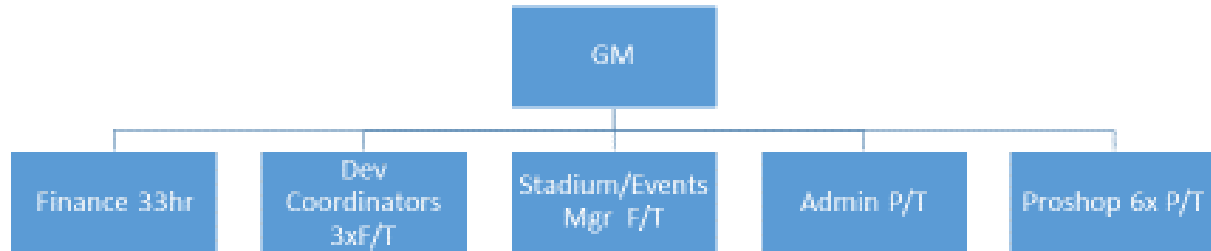
