



UNISS Selection Convenor - Deliverables

Overview

The UNISS Selection Convenor is responsible for leading the UNISS Selection Panel and convening player selections at the UNISS netball tournament.

Responsible to:

UNISS Organising Committee

Responsibilities and duties:

- To appoint selectors to the Selection Panel, and a Lead selector for each grade (with the support of the UNISS Organising Committee and appropriate Northern Zone/WBOP personnel)
- To undertake pre-tournament preparation tasks including communication with selectors, preparation of templates and equipment, and organising a pre-tournament selection panel meeting.
- To lead a fair and transparent selections process, delivered in line with the UNISS Selection Pack Policies and Procedures
- To complete post tournament administration tasks.

Estimated time commitment:

- Pre-tournament preparation tasks: estimated 2-4 hours.
- Pre-tournament selection panel meeting: estimated 1 hour.
- During tournament: estimated...
 - o between 8.00am and 5.45 pm Monday and Thursday.
 - between 8.00am and 7.45pm Tuesday and Wednesday.
 - o between 8.00am and 5.00pm Friday.
 - possible data entry and next-day preparation of up to 1 hour per evening.
- After tournament wrap up tasks: estimated 2 hours.

Tournament Dates:

Monday 2 September to Friday 6 September 2024

Remuneration/Fee:

For someone who is employed within the netball or sport sector and who can participate without taking leave from work: No remuneration will be paid

For someone whose employment role does not include/permit involvement and/or who are required to take leave from their regular employment to be a UNISS selector, a one-off fee of \$500 (including GST) will be paid.
