## SAFETY & COMPETENCY

Safety issues will be discussed in depth at the race briefing. However all competitor's buoyancy vests and helmets must comply with the CSNZ NZSS Rule 4. Classes of Boats and Equipment. It is recommended suitable boating footwear is worn around the site and warm paddling gear and clothing carried.

Be prepared for all weather conditions at this time of year.

Sunscreen (hopefully) and insect repellent are suggested.

Individual Schools are responsible for their own group safety during **any** practice sessions.

Competitors must display a suitable level of competency in the craft and category entered. If you have someone who can volunteer to help with safety please let us know.

## Scrutineering

The CSNZ NZSS Nationals are run under the guidelines of the ICF and the CSNZ NZSS Rules, however for the 2022 event the race committee is trialing a change around boat weights and will allow a boat with airbags to weigh an additional 600gram, thus removing the need for the airbags to be removed. The airbags must remain in the boat and if randomly scrutineered the 600gr will be taken into account.

For clarity this means a K1 boat with airbags must weigh at least 9.6kgs

C2 boat with airbags must weigh at least 15.6kgs

In all other matters boats and equipment must comply with CSNZ NZSS Rule 4. Classes of Boats and Equipment

## Boat sharing

Boat sharing is an individual school responsibility and whilst we appreciate this is necessary we reserve the right to disqualify athletes who can't start the race within the allotted time.

**The DR race will be raced in "Wavehopper" boats and these will be provided. All competitors will be required to use these boats. No other boats will be allowed.**

## Trophies and prizes

All individual competitors and schools should **return** cleaned trophies won by students at previous events for awarding at the prize giving. Please try and return earlier but if not **these should be bought to the managers meeting**. Please make sure they are engraved.

Medals will be awarded to competitors gaining 1st, 2nd and 3rd placing. Where international competitors are in the top 3 placing, the 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> or 3<sup>rd</sup> NZ competitor will also receive medals.
