

While 1926 was a good year for the club on the field, it was a bad one for the training shed and a haphazard one for Auckland rugby as a whole.

The training shed was flooded to a depth of six inches of water in May, although repairs were quickly carried out, and then suffered a second and far more destructive fire than in 1924 in early September. At least this time the club was insured, but the damage meant an almost total rebuild was needed.

The club season also dragged on, and very late in the piece one of the most bizarre matches ever considered by a body that came up with some beauts took place – the challenge by the Senior B winner to the Senior A champion, winner to take the Gallaher Shield. Which was a piece of nonsense, but it was in play this year – and hastily scrubbed when the silliest of all possible outcomes nearly happened.

Ponsonby won the Gallaher Shield in something of a cakewalk, winning all ten matches easily and only twice being held to a single-figure margin. The press often lamented that the standard of club football had gone down and that it was too easy for Ponsonby, and that the rep selectors had no option but to put half the champion side into the rep team as the other contenders didn't have that combination, or any number of other things that could be captured in one sentence: 'Ponsonby wins too easily, and the competition is boring.'

Simply brushing Ponsonby's record over three seasons off as being due to the weakness of the rest ignores everything that went into creating this powerhouse. And it should be remembered that 1926 wasn't as successful as 1925 had been, since a number of clubs really got stuck in down the grades.

When one looks at the playing personnel in the Senior side, it's not to be wondered at that they were so superior. Six All Blacks, most of whom were at their peak, one New Zealand Maori rep and half a dozen other respected provincial players have never formed a weak club side yet. But there was also what these men had done at club level to consider; the team was as settled as it ever was in the 1920s, and of the fifteen regulars, no fewer than 12 would fashion careers of at least 30 matches, with most having considerably more.

Report after report extols the quality of Ponsonby's back play; at one stage, writing about a Third Grade game, the scribe talked of the consistent quality throughout the club. The forwards were not the lightweight pack of four or five years earlier either; they were now one of the biggest sets in town, and certainly the fastest and most skilful.

What was perhaps upsetting the press most of all was that there was no indication this dominance was going to end any time soon – and in that they were absolutely correct.

Ponsonby, the strongest team in town by far, had streeted the championship field, only twice being held to single-figure margins. Ten Ponsonby players were in the various rep squads and this game was played ten weeks after the last championship match. North Shore had no such concerns and could focus on the game for weeks. Ponsonby won, 6-5, but the match exposed every flaw that existed in what was a bizarre system.
