CAR and DRIVER : All competitors must hold a current Speedway New Zealand licence and all vehicles must comply with the current Speedway New Zealand Rulebook and Supplementary Regulations

SOUND : A noise level of 95dba will be enforced and will be measured and monitored in accordance with Speedway New Zealand Rulebook

ELECTRONIC LAP SCORING : All vehicles must use a Dorian Data 1 TX8000TM transmitter and it must be working. Any without will not be permitted to take part in the event. McDonalds Kihikihi Speedway does not supply transmitters.

RACEIVERS: All competitors must have their own functioning receiver in accordance with SNZ Rules

NUMBERS : You will not need to change your racing number

STICKERS : Sponsors decals may be affixed to your vehicle for the duration of the event

POSTPONEMENT : In the event of a rain out, the Promotion will hold this event on the Sunday 23rd February 2020

Roll Call and Drivers Briefing 3.45

Racing starts at 5pm

MEETING FORMAT M4-30 (Number Dependand)

HEATS : The field will be split into 2 qualifying groups

Each group will compete in two (2) 12 lap heats

The top 7 cars on accumulated points in each group will go through to the final

REPERCHARGE : There will be one repercharge to find the final 4 qualifiers who will start from grids 15, 16, 17, 18 in the final

CONSOLATION : there will be a consolation race for the non qualifiers

FINAL : The highest points scorer will choose between lanes 1 or 2 for the final. All other drivers will start in descending order of points scored in the qualifying heats. Any tied points will be determined by fastest lap times in either of the 2 qualifying heats.

The final will be 20 laps

The winner of the final race will be the New Zealand Saloon GP Champion

The rest of the placings will be awarded in finishing order
