Natahlia Moors: When she made her Auckland debut as a 20-year-old in 2015, and scoring nine tries in yet another Storm title run, Natahlia Moors was tagged as a rising talent in the New Zealand game. Before that, she had been given the same label in Australia – she represented Australia at Youth Olympics – but eventually decided to give rugby her best shot in New Zealand. It proved to be a wise choice, as she quickly made a mark in Sevens, making the Development Sevens squad in 2017 and 2018, before returning to first-class play in the latter year and doing enough to win a Black Ferns call-up for the end-of-year tour. She held her place in 2019, although still not cracking the starting lineup in the face of some serious competition, and played well for the Development team in a four-way Oceania tournament in Fiji, topping the try count with six for a team that scored 234 points and conceded none. Capable of playing any position in the back three, it may be that fullback eventually proves to be her best.
