<u>Permit 2512F</u>

The Ferris Trophy Night Meeting will be carried out under the KartSport New Zealand Regulations, Codes, Rules, Procedures and Technical Specifications.

<u>Eligibility</u>

Any member of a KartSport New Zealand affiliated club or Day Licence holder may enter the Club Meeting and will be recognised in the event's results.

Licence ratings, X, Club, Tier 1 and Tier 2.

<u>Classes</u>

Classes shall be as per KartSport New Zealand Regulations, Codes, Rules, Procedures and Technical Specifications.

Trophies will be awarded to competitors in the following classes with minimum entries of 3 for the KartSport Nelson 2024 Ferris Trophy Night Meeting. Seniors classes may be combined at committee discretion to achieve minimum numbers.

Ferris Trophy Twilight Meeting Format

First 3 heats, predetermined grid system. Prefinal, reverse grid of the lowest points from the 3 heats. Final, grid based off lowest points of all heats.

The Points system is: 1 point for 1st, 2 points for 2nd, 3 points for 3rd, etc. DNS is Field plus 1. Ties Rule P 2.7

All races count towards the overall result.

Entry Fee

\$65 per driver/rider. Capped at \$130 per family. \$45 entry fee for a second class per driver. (The definition of a family will be at the discretion of the KartSport Nelson Committee, but in general covers Parents/caregivers and their children and siblings). No other discounts will apply.

Lighting on Karts

You can run LED strip lights on either your seat or steering column stays only. If you need to use another battery it will need to comply with rule K1.37, the same as your normal battery.

You can also run valve cap LED's.

Clear visors must be worn when the lights are on.

General and Technical

Push Back Nose Cones (Rule K1.42.1) will be used at this event.

This event will be run under Rule C4.2 where PNRs brought against a competitor by a race official will be noncontestable.

Teching will be at the discretion of the Tech Officials.

Classes that are eligible under KartSport New Zealand rules to run together may be required to do so at the discretion of the race officials. These classes will be gridded separately and have separate results and trophies.

Pit sites are on a first in first served basis other than the leased pit sites which are leased by members for the year. A list of leased pit sites/shelters is on the Clubroom window. Please be respectful of other competitors when setting up your pit site making sure you are not blocking off access to other pit sites and be mindful when using generators or power equipment. Pit site control will be at the discretion of either the KartSport Nelson committee or the KartSport New Zealand race officials. No vehicles to be parked on the sealed pit area unless the competitor is working out of the vehicle.

There is an engine revving area in front of the tech shed where warming up of engines can be carried out.

Unsportsmanlike behaviour will not be tolerated. Any competitor or their crew who are deemed to have acted in an unsportsmanlike manner will be dealt with in terms of KartSport New Zealand rules and the KartSport Nelson committee reserves the right to take further action to exclude them from the Club or event.
